What that means for me...

I. When I say yes to Jesus, He really will change my life.

2Cor. 5:17 What this means is that those who become Christians become new persons. They are not the same anymore, for the old life is gone. A new life has begun!

II. When I trust Jesus I know I'm heaven bound!

1Cor. 6:14 Now God has not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us up through His **power**. See also: John 11:25

John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies..."

III. When I follow Jesus my life becomes extraordinary.

Eph. 3:20 Now glory be to God! By his mighty power at work within us, he is able to accomplish infinitely more than we would ever dare to ask or hope. See also: Acts 1:8, 2 Tim. 1:7
