



## WEEK 3 | HOME CONNECT

### I Will Build Trust

#### TALK TOGETHER

**SAY:** We're in week three of our series "Brick by Brick!" Let's see if we remember who the main character of our Bible story is? (Moses) Great! Now, before we get started, let's share who our favorite superhero is!

#### READ TOGETHER

**SAY:** Remember, we're learning all about Moses' life. Last week, we talked about Moses and the burning bush, where God told Moses that he would be the one leading the Israelites out of Egypt, where they were slaves. Today, we're going to find out how God made it happen. Moses may have been scared, but God showed up and took care of it all! Let's turn to or watch to see what happens. (PREK/KINDER: Beginner Bible "Ten Plagues" - or click on the link- <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rzcYLCYItuc>)

**AFTER SAY:** God did it! He really brought the Israelites out of Egypt! It took so many tries for Pharaoh to finally let them go. But God, our Master Builder, can make anything happen! What do you think was the WORST plague, before the last one? (allow kids to say which one they disliked the most, then answer for yourself.) Right! I think \_\_\_ was the worst plague! YUCK! Sometimes our lives can be full of hard times, when it feels like everything is hard and scary.

#### PREK/KINDER QUESTIONS

1. Did Pharaoh want to let the Israelites to leave or stay? Pharaoh wanted them to stay.
2. Did God send plagues or presents to the Pharaoh to make him change his mind? Yes, God send plagues.
3. Did God send frogs or kangaroos as one of the plagues? Frogs

#### ELEMENTARY QUESTIONS

1. Can you think of one time that life was really hard or scary, and then it turned out okay in the end? (allow kids to answer, if they choose. Share for yourself first to make kids feel safe.)

**SAY:** God is always working for our good. Moses and the Israelites had to trust God when Pharaoh wasn't letting the people go. Just like Moses, we can build trust with God because he makes good things out of hard times.

## PLAY TOGETHER

**SUPPLIES:** Printed Spot It Game (below)

**SAY:** Let's play **LEGO Spot-It!** In this game, I'll hold up two cards- they've got some LEGO Mini Figure faces on them. When I hold them, you guys tell me which face is matching on both cards!

- **HOLD** the cards with the number 1 and wait for kids to shout happy face! **ASK:** Do you think Moses was happy when God asked him to go back to Egypt? No! He was scared!
- **HOLD** the cards with the number 2 and wait for kids to shout heart eyes! **ASK:** Do you think Pharaoh loved the idea of letting the Israelites go? No! he wanted them to work for him!
- **HOLD** the cards with the number 3 and wait for kids to shout surprised face! **ASK:** Do you think Moses was surprised when Pharaoh let them go? Yes! God worked a miracle for the Israelites!
- **HOLD** the cards with the number 4 and wait for kids to shout worried! **ASK:** Do you think Moses was worried about talking to Pharaoh? Yes! Pharaoh was a very important leader!
- **HOLD** the cards with the number 5 and wait for kids to shout sunglasses! **ASK:** When in the story did someone feel like this emoji? Moses after Pharaoh agreed to let them go, God when he sent the plagues, the Israelites when they walked out of Egypt...
- **HOLD** the cards with the number 6 and wait for kids to shout angry! **ASK:** Who do you think was the most angry in our story? God at Pharaoh, or Pharaoh at the Israelites

## PRAY TOGETHER

**WEEKLY CHALLENGE:** Now that we know that we can trust God, what can you do this week to show God that you trust him? Is there something happening that you need to trust God with? (answer first, and then ask kids to answer. Be real with them, and they'll be more real with you! This is a great opportunity to take another step closer in your relationship with these kids)

**SAY:** Remember, God is the Master Builder, and he is working for your good! Remind yourself of that when you are afraid- we can build trust with God!
